HOW TO ENROL TO THE COURSE:

Considered the limited seats available, interested PhD Candidates must apply through the dedicated form (link may be found at the Doctoral School website) by the given deadline.

Should the applications exceed the number of spots available for the 2024 class, participants will be selected based on their motivation letter (to be uploaded to the form) and on objective needs to learn German related to the implementation of their research projects.

They will be taken in consideration:

planned periods of research abroad in German-speaking countries,





- subject of the research project
- aspects of implementation of the project (i.e. analysis of German documents and archive research, collaboration with German-speaking institutions, research groups or private entities, etc.)

Priority could be assigned to PhD Candidates on their last year of research or to those who have periods abroad in German-speaking countries actually planned.

The list of accepted participants to the course will be compiled by the PhD Office and the teacher. Their decision is not questionable.

All applicants will receive communication of the results of their application by the **12**th of January 2024.

DEADLINE TO ENROLL:

5th of January at 5 pm (CET Time) – Link available on the Doctoral School website.

DESCRIPTION OF THE COURSE:

The German language course is dedicated to PhD Candidates who have no knowledge/absolute beginner of German and particularly to PhD Candidates who needs to acquire some knowledge of German for the implementation of their PhD research project.

The "A1" (beginner level) refers to the level of knowledge you can acquire by attending this course.

COURSE COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS:

During the course remote activities and assignments will be provided by the teacher. Certificates of attendance will be provided only to participants that will attend at least **20 hours** of lessons and will complete at least 3 assignments.
