The Doctoral School of the University invites you to participate in the training course "Bibliography and bibliometrics like pros: Stay up to date and Develop Literature Syntheses in the Biomedical Domain", as a part of the initiatives of complementary research training organized with the Library Services of the University (<u>Medical Sciences Hub</u>).

This training will be held on-line. The course will last **14 hours**:

8 hours need to be completed autonomously at the dedicated **Moodle** platform within the period **1st February 2023 – 14th May 2023**;

6 hours will consist in **3 Webex webinars** of 2 hours each, scheduled on the following dates:

15th May 2023, 11:00-13:00 17th May 2023, 11:00-13:00 18th May 2023, 11:00-13:00

The training is directed primarily to doctoral candidates of the medical research areas, but is open to all.

<u>Discussed topics</u>: Overview of literature syntheses - Methods for a systematic approach to literature search - Searching bibliographic and citation databases (e.g. PubMed / Embase) - Feedly to follow literature updates - Reference Management Software (e.g. Zotero) - Publish with impact: paper/journal/author-level metrics from Scopus and WoS
